Research Analysis

HB 2010 creates Andy's Law and requires any motorized vessel manufactured prior to 2008 to have a carbon monoxide warning sticker in plain view to the interior of the vessel. The Department of Public Safety is to develop a carbon monoxide warning sticker and literature on the dangers of carbon monoxide and boating. Service Oklahoma is to provide the stickers and literature to vessel owners in annual registration materials.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2010 creates "Andy's Law," a law that requires any motorized vessel will be required to have a carbon monoxide warning sticker affixed in the interior of the vessel. Service Oklahoma and its licensed operators will provide these stickers along with literature on the dangers of carbon monoxide to vessel owners with their annual registration materials. Service Oklahoma shall collect a fee at the cost at which the sticker is produced, so cost of the sticker will be deferred to the consumer. Per Service Oklahoma, administrative changes due to this change would be minimal.
