Research Analysis

HB 2060, as introduced, requires landscapers to first obtain a license from the Oklahoma Board of Agriculture before conducting business. The measure also requires restricted-use pesticide dealers to only sell such pesticides to holders of a valid applicator's license or another restricted-use pesticide dealer's permit holder. Dealers who violate this law will be fined \$1,500.
