**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 2084 requires wine sold for off-premises consumption to be in a sealed container from the winemaker licensee and transferred within the license premises by an employee who is at least 18 years old and verifies the age of the recipient upon delivery. If the employee cannot safely verify the recipient's age or intoxication level, they must cancel the sale.
