Research Analysis

The conference committee substitute to House Bill 2137 establishes a definition for "residential zone" to mean a 75-mile radius surrounding a servicemember's permanent place of dwelling located within the servicemember's state of legal residence or domicile. The measure modifies the definition of "deployment" as used in the Deployed Parents Custody and Visitation Act to include this term, and expands the definition of "servicemember" to include the active or reserve components of the Space Force.
