**Research Analysis**

HB2142, as introduced, allows CLEET certified high school police officers to become members of the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System if the school board that employs the officer elects to become an OLERS participating employer. The measure outlines the procedures for an officer to make an election to transition from the Oklahoma Teachers' Retirement System to OLERS. Service credit can also be transferred at a prorated share or purchased at actuarial cost.
