Research Analysis

The floor amendment to HB 2151 names the act the "Drunk Impaired Accountability Law (D.I.A.L.). The amendment requires the Department to offer the contract to develop the app to an existing state vendor with similar experience in developing such applications if the Department chooses to contract rather than develop the application themselves.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure creates new law that would require the Department of Public Safety (DPS) to develop or contract to develop a cellular phone application that allows for the tracking of individuals convicted of the offense of driving while under the influence of alcohol or other intoxicating substance. DPS estimates the cost for discovery, development, and implementation of the requirements of HB2151 to be \$100,000. The floor amendment does not affect the fiscal impact of the measure.
