Research Analysis

HB2210 provides that if a minor is convicted as an adult and the court finds that the person against whom the minor committed the offense trafficked, sexually abused, or sexually assaulted the minor within one year, the court may depart from the mandatory minimum or sentence enhancement, suspend any portion or an otherwise applicable sentence, or transfer the minor to juvenile jurisdiction.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure would allow the courts to depart from certain sentencing requirements in cases where a minor has committed an offense against a person who has sexually abused or sexually assaulted the minor within one year before the commission of the offense by the minor. In its current form, HB2210 is not anticipated to have an impact on state budget or appropriations.
