**Research Analysis**

HB 2243 modifies the vehicles exempted from the requirement to have an odometer disclosure statement upon transfer of ownership. The measure exempts vehicles that were manufactured in or before the 2010 model year. For vehicles manufactured in 2011 or later that is transferred at least 20 years after January 1 of the calendar year corresponding to its designated model year are also exempted from the odometer disclosure statement.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2243 clarifies that any vehicle manufactured in or before the 2010 model year, or any vehicle manufactured in or after the 2011 model year that is transferred at least twenty (20) years after January 1 of the calendar year corresponding to its designated model year, is exempt from odometer disclosure statements. This measure would not change current Service Oklahoma practice in regards to odometer exemptions; therefore, this measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
