Research Analysis

The CS to HB 2253 provides that vehicles used by the Office of the Attorney General vehicles designated for use by agents and other employees are not required to be officially marked as State of Oklahoma vehicles. The measure allows the Office of the Attorney General to purchase vehicles and allow employees to use a state-owned or state-leased vehicle to provide transportation between the residence of the employee and the assigned place of employment.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2253 allows the Office of the Attorney General to purchase vehicles and allows employees to use a state-owned vehicles for transportation between the residence of the employee and the place of employment for the employee. While this measure does not require the agency to purchase vehicles, the agency has stated it may request appropriations in the future to cover the expenses of vehicle purchases; for this reason, HB 2253 has a potential to require appropriated dollars in future fiscal years.
