**Research Analysis**

The floor amendment adds an emergency. The CS to HB 2253 provides that vehicles used by the Office of the Attorney General vehicles designated for use by agents and other employees are not required to be officially marked as State of Oklahoma vehicles. The measure allows the Office of the Attorney General to purchase vehicles and allow employees to use a state-owned or state-leased vehicle to provide transportation between the residence of the employee and the assigned place of employment.
