Research Analysis

HB 2255 authorizes the creation new license plates to be designed and issued to persons wishing to support various entities. The measure creates the following license plates:

Hallett Motor Racing Circuit License Plate

Ally's House License Plate

U.S. Army Ranger License Plate

45th Infantry Brigade Combat Team License Plate

University of Kansas License Plate

Clinton Red Tornadoes License Plate

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2255 creates a U.S. Army Ranger specialty license plate and a 45th Infantry Brigade Combat Team specialty license plate, to be created and distributed by Service Oklahoma. The annual fee for this license plate will be eight dollars (\$8.00), to be deposited in the Service Oklahoma Reimbursement Fund.

This measure also creates a Hallett Motor Racing Circuit specialty license plate, a University of Kansas specialty license plate, and a Clinton Red Tornadoes specialty license plate, each to be created and distributed by Service Oklahoma. The annual fee for this license plate will be fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per year. Eight dollars (\$8.00) of this fee will be deposited in the Service Oklahoma Reimbursement Fund and the remaining seven dollars (\$7.00) will be apportioned as provided in Title 47 Section 1104 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

This measure also creates a Ally's House License Plate to be created and distributed by Service Oklahoma. The annual fee for this license plate will be thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) with twenty dollars (\$20.00) of that fee being sent to Ally's House and the remaining fifteen dollars (\$15.00) distributed in the same manner as described above.

The creation of these license plates would result in a minimal increase in motor vehicle collections to Service Oklahoma from any individual who chooses to receive this plate.

The Senate amendment accepts the restoration of the title, and makes no change in the fiscal impact analysis from the previous House Floor version of the measure.
