## **Research Analysis**

HB 2355, as introduced, clarifies that any lifetime hunting license is valid in place of all species specific licenses, an Oklahoma waterfowl hunting stamp, wildlife conservation passport, fur license, annual trapping license, controlled hunt permits, and all carcass tags. Further, the measure provides that air bows are a legal hunting method any time there's an open hunting season.
