## **Research Analysis**

HB 2361 requires a reserve minimum bid to be placed on properties being sold by a county that covers any taxes, abatement costs, penalties, interests, or other costs due to a municipality if notice is given to the county treasurer. The measure provides for property and nuisance property to be bid off in the name of a municipality if that municipality has outstanding liens on the property and request it in writing. Lastly, the measure amends the definition of *nuisance property*.
