## **Research Analysis**

The PCS for HB 2367 creates exceptions to the Open Meeting Act for the Oklahoma Corporation Commission so that commissioners may discuss matters other than appropriation of OCC funds and attend events even if a quorum is present. Within five days of the event where a quorum is present, the commissioners must report on its website the subject matter received or discussed, unless the OCC wishes to take potential action on the subject. In that case, the potential action item shall be documented a least 48 hours before the OCC considers the item. Lastly, the measure requires periodic training on the Open Meeting Act for commissioners and designated staff.
