HB 2424, as introduced, replaces the term naloxone with the term opioid antagonist, and allows for any opioid antagonist that is approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration to be dispensed or sold by a pharmacy without a prescription. So long as the opioid antagonist is dispensed or sold only by, or under the supervision of, a licensed pharmacist.
