**Research Analysis**

The senate amendment to HB 2426 repeals two sections of law in Title 63, which relate to the Oklahoma 9-1-1 Management Authority Act. The two sections are:

- [Section 2814](#), also renumbered as [Title 63 Section 2869.1](#); and
- [Section 2815](#), also renumbered as [Title 63 Section 2869.2](#).

**Fiscal Analysis**

The Senate amendments to HB 2426 repeal two sections of statute related to the collection of 911 landline fees. With the passage and implementation of HB 1897 (2023), the repealer sections of HB 1590 (2023) were not implemented due to a change in statute location. The intent of this measure is clean-up language related to HB 1590. As of January 2024, no 911 centers received any direct funding related to the fee structure being repealed in this measure.
