**Research Analysis**

The floor substitute for HB 2429 lowers the age requirement to apply for an initial fire extinguisher business license issued by the State Fire Marshal from 21 to 18. The measure also removes the requirements to provide photos, fingerprints, and scope of business statements upon application.

**CHANGES BETWEEN FLOOR VERSION AND FLOOR SUBSTITUTE**

- Shifts the focus of the measure to modifying the initial fire extinguisher license application process rather than the type of fire extinguisher license.
