Fiscal Analysis

This measure creates the Oklahoma Prisoner Reentry Pilot program. This is an expansion of re-entry services which the Department of Corrections (DOC) provides through the Sarah Stitt Act and the ReMerge Program. The DOC estimates an additional cost of roughly \$35,000 per participant for services in HB2517 that are not provided for through existing programs. Given the cost per participant, the possible impact to the state budget would vary based on the size of the pilot program.
