Research Analysis

HB 2562, as introduced, makes changes to the State Board of Education. The measure increases the size of the board from 7 members to 11. The Governor is authorized to appoint six of those members. The Speaker and Pro Tem are authorized to appoint two members each. The Speaker and Pro Tem must each appoint a resident of a rural community and a former school superintendent from a district with an enrollment of less than 10,000.
