**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 2569 imposes a moratorium on the State Board of Education's ability to approve and impose new school accreditation rules without specific legislative authorization. The Office of Educational Quality and Accountability must review and prepare a report, by January 1, 2024, of all statutes and rules the State Board uses to determine school accreditation and deficiencies.
