Research Analysis

HB 2597 raises the monthly travel allowance for county commissioners and sheriffs from \$700 to \$770.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2597 in its current form increases from \$700 to \$770 the monthly travel allowance for county commissioners and county sheriffs. Each county has three county commissioners and one sheriff, so each county will have 4 officials eligible for the \$70 increase, equating to a per county per month cost of \$280. Annualized the cost of HB 2597 would be \$3,360 per county, (12 months * \$280), or \$258,720 statewide, (77 counties * \$3,360).

HB 2597 imposes additional expenses on counties; however, the measure has no direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
