HB 2723, as introduced, enacts the "Interstate Licensed Professional Counselors Compact", allowing licensed professional counselors in any state that has also joined the compact to provide licensed professional counseling and telehealth services in each member state under a privilege to practice.

Fiscal Analysis

HB2723 proposes to create the Interstate Licensed Professional Counselors Compact for the purpose of facilitating interstate practice of licensed professional counselors. This measure does not mandate any action to any state agency and does not provide for any licensure fees.
