**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2741 creates a new cause of action that may be filed in district court. According to the Administrative Director of the Courts, there would be minimal fiscal impact if new cases are filed, and court costs (already set by statute) are collected upon filing. As a result, the provisions of the measure are assumed to be objective within the agency's existing resources; thus, having no direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.

The CCR to HB 2741 restores title.
