Research Analysis

HB 2753 requires the Office of the Attorney General to maintain the Vulnerable Adult Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation registry to include names, identifiable information, and case descriptions for individuals who have been convicted of abuse, neglect or exploitation of a vulnerable adult. The public registry will be updated quarterly.

The Senate amendment to HB 2753 changes the list of information required to be included on the registry by removing the date the individual was listed on the registry, and replacing it with the date the individual was convicted or pled guilty or nolo contendere.
