**Research Analysis**

HB 2790, as introduced, establishes The Oklahoma Hospital Cybersecurity Protection Act of 2023. The measure is voluntary, and allows for covered entities to seek an affirmative defense under the measure should an allegation arise that the failure to implement reasonable information security controls resulted in a data breach concerning personal information or restricted information. The measure also outlines the mandatory conditions which allow a covered entity to seek an affirmative defense under the measure.
