**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 2841 requires the State Board of Agriculture to pay agriculture law enforcement agents no less than 90 percent of the average salary of a state trooper.

**Fiscal Analysis**

This measure pegs the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry (ODAFF's) CLEET licensed investigators salaries to ninety percent (90% ) of State Trooper's salaries. ODAFF currently has 9 investigators, all making below that 90% threshold. To raise all 9 employees' salaries up to the threshold plus the increase to benefits that accompany that raise, the total additional three hundred one thousand, two hundred seventy-nine dollars (\$301,279.00). This measure therefore creates a fiscal impact to the state of \$301,279.00.
