**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB 2892 authorizes the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority to utilize \$80 million from the Legacy Capital Financing Fund to construct, refurbish, or expand engineering facilities at the University of Oklahoma.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2892 allocates Eighty Million Dollars (\$80,000,000) from the Legacy Capital Financing Fund to the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority for the benefit of the University of Oklahoma to construct or expand facilities utilized in the instruction of engineering curriculum to increase capacity for research, experiential learning, and engineering collaboration spaces. Thus, this measure creates an \$80,000,000 impact for the state.
