**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 2917 modifies the initial funding formula for charter schools and virtual charter schools. The current method of multiplying a school's enrollment on August 1 by 1.333 yearly is modified to only occur during the school's first year of operation. For each subsequent year, the standard general formula will be used to calculate funding.
