Research Analysis

The second proposed committee substitute for HB2923 rejects the 17 percent across-the-board pay raise for state judges as recommended by the Board on Judicial Compensation. Instead, a 7 percent raise is proposed by the Legislature for district, associate district and special district judges effective July 1, 2024.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure rejects the Board on Judicial Compensation's recommendation of a 17% judicial salary increase. HB2923 provides for a salary increase of 7% for District Judges, Associate District Judges, and Special District Judges at a cost of \$3,170,497 to the District Courts (DC). The District Attorneys Council (DAC) anticipates a need for \$373,710 to fund salaries that are statutorily tied to these judicial salaries.
