**Research Analysis**

HB2988, as introduced, eliminates the veteran's registry registration deadline of November 1, 2023 so that qualifying disabled veterans who had been receiving the sales tax exemption prior to November 1, 2020 do not lose their exemption status for failure to meet the registration deadline.

**Fiscal Analysis**

As introduced, HB2988 proposes to remove the requirement that veterans receiving the sales tax exemption afforded to 100% disabled veterans prior to November 1, 2020 must register with the veterans' registry prior to July 1, 2023 to remain qualified. This measure is not expected to impact state revenue or state appropriations.

OTC Analysis:

**REVENUE IMPACT:**

Currently, vendors are honoring the sales tax exemption of 100% disabled veterans permit holders whose registration on the veterans' registry has not been completed. Therefore, no impact to sales tax collections is anticipated as a result of this proposal.
