HB 2995 requires an agreement to exist between a restaurant and a courier application service, such as Grub Hub, Door Dash, etc., in order to transport for delivery.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure requires courier applications to have an agreement in place with restaurants to transport food, and for those services with no agreement in place, a compliant may be filed with the Consumer Services Division of the Oklahoma Corporation Commission (Corp. Comm.). Corp. Comm. believes this measure will require several new staff to be hired at a total of \$380,000 for those staff. Additionally, Corp. Comm. believes the rule making process around this measure will cost the agency about \$50,000. Together, the total cost of the measure is \$430,000. As Corp. Comm. is an appropriated agency, there is a fiscal impact to the State from this measure.
