**HB 3001** as introduced, raises the contract amount not subject to the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974 that the Department of Corrections is allowed to extend during a declared emergency from \$250,000 to \$500,000.

**Fiscal Analysis**

This measure raises the emergency purchasing limit for the Department of Corrections (DOC) from \$250,000 to \$500,000. The measure provides flexibility to the agency to spend existing budgetary resources and requires no additional funding.
