Research Analysis

The floor amendment to House Bill 3033 deletes all references to the "State Department of Health" and replaces them with the "Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services".

Fiscal Analysis

The floor amendment to HB 3033 creates the Oklahoma Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Grant Program, to be administered by the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (ODMHSAS), in effort to increase the number of adolescent psychiatric beds available in Oklahoma. The program is to be used for facilities where a Public Trust Hospital is donating the space and staff to support the facility and must be located in counties with a population of less than forty-five thousand (45,000) people.

In addition, this measure establishes the "Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Revolving Fund," allowing ODMHSAS to retain one percent (1%) of appropriated funds to cover administrative costs related to the Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Program. As a result, officials from ODMHSAS anticipate the fiscal impact to be minimal and captured within the agency's current budgetary resources. There are no further considerations to the state budget or appropriation.
