Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to House Bill 3033 establishes the "Oklahoma Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Grant Program" to be administered by the State Department of Health to fund the remodeling or construction of facilities to accommodate adolescent psychiatric patients. Facilities must be in counties with populations under 45,000 as per the 2020 Census and supported by a Public Trust Hospital providing both space and staffing. The program requires annual reporting on grants awarded and project progress. Additionally, the measure creates the "Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Revolving Fund" to finance the grant program, with a portion retained for administrative costs.

Fiscal Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to HB 3033 creates the Oklahoma Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Grant Program, to be administered by the State Department of Health (OSDH), in effort to increase the number of adolescent psychiatric beds available in Oklahoma. The program is to be used for facilities where a Public Trust Hospital is donating the space and staffing needs to support the facility and must be located in counties with a population of less than forty-five thousand (45,000) people.

In addition, this measure establishes the "Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Revolving Fund," allowing OSDH to retain one percent (1%) of appropriated funds to cover administrative costs related to the Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Program. As a result, officials from OSDH anticipate the fiscal impact to be minimal and captured within the agency's current budgetary resources. There are no further considerations to the state budget or appropriation.
