HB3036, as introduced, eliminates the option for a jury trial for forcible entry and detainer lawsuits.

The measure also repeals <u>Title 12</u>, <u>Section 1148.8</u> which allows a judge to require the county sheriff to round up potential jurors when no jury is available from the general panel.
