**Research Analysis**

House Bill 3040, as introduced, requires the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to include a line item in its annual budget request to cover the costs of reimbursing nursing facilities and intermediate care facilities for individuals with intellectual disabilities. The reimbursement amount should reflect the most recent audited cost.

**Fiscal Analysis**

In its current form, HB 3040 requires Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA) to specify in their annual budget request to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) additional state and federal funding required to cover the increased costs associated with reimbursing nursing and intermediate care facilities for individuals with intellectual disabilities.

OHCA confirmed the data to be reported, as outlined in this measure, is feasible within current budgetary resources. Therefore, this measure is not anticipated to have a negative fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
