As introduced, HB3054 proposes to expand the property tax exemption for oil and gas infrastructure to include flowlines and gathering lines going from the wellhead to the point of custody transfer.

Oklahoma Tax Commission Analysis:

REVENUE IMPACT:

There is no impact on tax revenue to the State. Adding additional exempt property as outlined in HB 3054 may, at minimum, result in a loss of \$8,600,888² in tax revenue to local jurisdictions.

FY 25: No impact to state tax revenue; estimated minimum reduction of \$8,600,888 to local jurisdictions.
