**Research Analysis**

HB 3072 requires a driver approaching a stationary authorized emergency vehicle or other designated vehicle displaying flashing lights to slow to a speed that is at least 10 miles per hour below the posted speed limit when approaching such vehicle. Person's committing a first offense may complete the Operation Work Zone Awareness program to avoid the monetary penalty.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3072 requires a driver to reduce their speed to at least ten (10) miles per hour below the posted speed limit when approaching a stationary vehicle displaying flashing lights. This measure allows persons committing a first offense of this violation to complete the Operation Work Zone Awareness program to avoid the monetary penalty. Any person who completes this program pays a fee of Seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) that is apportioned to various revolving funds. This measure may generate additional revenues to the revolving funds noted in statute, but the frequency of first-time offenders cannot be predicted.
