Fiscal Analysis

HB 3080 establishes that each General Election date is to be designated a formal state holiday. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) states that although this designation would not cause a direct increase in expenses to the State of Oklahoma, there would be an estimated loss of production of Nine Million, Nine Hundred and Forty-Two Thousand, Eight Hundred and Eight Dollars (\$9,942,808.00). The estimate provided is the average cost of payroll per day for all state employees.
