HB 3093, as introduced, prohibits insurers from terminating or increasing the premium of a motor vehicle policy that has been active for more than 45 days solely because the insured filed a first claim.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3093 prohibits insurance carrier's from canceling or refusing to renew a policy due to the insured individual filing their first claim when the policy has been activated for at least forty-five (45) days.
