HB 3098 adds to the list of diseases for which a person may be criminally charged for intentionally spreading. The measure adds bacterial vaginosis, chlamydia, hepatitis, herpes, human papillomavirus infection, mycoplasma genitalium, pelvic inflammatory disease, and trichomoniasis.
