Fiscal Analysis

HB 3153 restricts the total amount of public land owned by the State and Federal government to be no more than twelve percent (12%) of the total land in the state. Currently, the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) estimates that the total shared ownership of both Federal and State-owned land is approximately five percent (5%).

This measure also requires the release of any easements held by the State for a period of longer than thirty (30) years. OMES cannot fully project the full fiscal impact of vacating these easements, but the agency estimates the cost of renewing an existing no-cost easement to be approximately Sixty Thousand dollars (\$60,000.00) per easement.

Overall, this measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state at this time.
