Research Analysis

HB 3160 expands the scope of the duties of the Attorney General to investigate and prosecute any criminal actions alleged to have occurred on the grounds of the State Capitol Complex in Oklahoma City if, in the opinion of the Attorney General, a criminal prosecution is warranted, or to refer such matters to the appropriate district attorney.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3160 adds the additional responsibility of the Attorney General's office of investigating and prosecuting criminal actions on the grounds of the State Capitol. Per the Attorney General's office, this additional responsibility would result in the need for at least one additional attorney and two investigators to be able to handle this new investigative authority. The total fiscal impact of these new positions is estimated to be Four Hundred Fourteen Thousand dollars (\$414,000.00). As the Attorney General is an appropriated state agency, this would result in a fiscal impact of \$414,000 to state budget resources.
