**Research Analysis**

HB 3168, as introduced, prohibits insurers from requiring claimants to use methods other than personal inspection, such as photographs or telephone calls, to obtain an estimate. Insurers must also obtain consent from the policyholder for every claim filed.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3168 prohibits insurers requiring an estimate for motor vehicle repairs in any manner other than an actual personal inspection, including photographs and telephone calls, without the claimant's consent. This measure has no direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
