**Research Analysis**

HB 3187, as introduced, modifies provisions related to the boards of directors of free county and township fair associations. The measure:

- Adds digital and electronic communication and Internet equipment as an eligible expense for the boards of directors;
- Requires members-elect of the county fair association to designate a day where they have a 12-hour window to vote for board positions; and
- Allows board members to vote for the removal of a board member who has attended fewer than 75 percent of the meetings in a calendar year.
