Research Analysis

HB 3192, as introduced, adds terms to the state forestry code: *control line*, *fire line*, *hazardous duty*, and *wildland firefighter*. The measure also:

- Revises the template for the prescribed burn notification plan, which is to be filed the nearest rural fire department; and
- Adds liability protections for forest rangers who conduct prescribed burns on public or private lands with the consent of the landowner.
