## **Research Analysis**

HB 3213 provides that when any portion of a dedicated road, street, or highway, as dedicated by a plat map or deed or Oklahoma Organic Act of 1890 reserved right-of-way, touches the municipal limits of a city or town, the entire portion of the dedicated road, street, or highway is to be considered the boundary line regardless of the location of the paved portion of the road, street, or highway.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3213 established that if any portion of a dedicated road, street, or highway touches the municipal limits of a city or town, the entire portion of the road, street, or highway forms the boundary line of a city or town. This measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
