**Research Analysis**

HB 3217 as introduced, prohibits state agencies from using state funds to organize or endorse any event, official communication, or educational program that promotes LGBTQI Pride Month. The measure also prohibits any flag that recognizes sexual orientation or gender identity from being displayed by a state agency on state property.
