Research Analysis

HB 3220 prohibits a police officer or sheriff from releasing a person arrested for a second or subsequent DUI without the violator appearing before a magistrate, judge, or court. Before determining bond, the magistrate, judge, or court is to consider any evidence that the person is dependent upon alcohol or a controlled dangerous substance or has a pattern of regular abuse of alcohol or drugs and present written findings on the bail amount. The measure clarifies the procedure for obtaining a blood withdrawal for blood alcohol testing by allowing duly authorized peace officer to provide a written statement that there are exigent circumstances which necessitate the withdrawal of blood.
