**Fiscal Analysis**

In its current form, HB3240 requires the Ad Valorem Division of the Oklahoma Tax Commission (OTC) to share location and address data upon request from an agency designated as the Census Bureau State Data Center.

The subcommittee recommendation does not change the fiscal impact of the bill.

**OTC Analysis:**

Currently, the Ad Valorem Division does not collect or house the information required to administer this proposal<sup>1</sup>. Additional statutory authority may be necessary to obtain the information needed to administer the provisions of HB 3240, although a complete dataset of location and address information is not known to exist in the state. There would be administrative costs associated with efforts to obtain this information, however, a specific estimate of those costs is unknown at this time<sup>2</sup>.
